Note: A trip leader may turn you away for not having adequate equipment, but it's your responsibility to make sure you have it. A trip leader may also require that you bring additional equipment.

**Minimum Equipment for All Club Trips** 

PFD (approved life jacket)

Spray skirt

Flotation in both ends of boat (air bags or bulkheads)

**Bailing device** Rain gear and hat

Warm change of clothes (polypro type preferred)

Fresh water

Basic outdoor items, incl. whistle, waterproof matches/lighter, flashlight, sunglasses and

sunscreen, knife

**Highly Recommended for All Trips** 

Paddle leash

Paddle float for self rescue

**Compass** 

Charts of area

First aid kit

**Flares** 

**Flashlight** 

Extra food

**Tow line (50')** 

Recommended equipment for trip leaders includes all the above, plus:

Watch Rescue slings and tow rope

**Current tables** Repair kit: pliers, duct tape, screw driver,

Waterproof flashlight

Spare paddle Sleeping bag in dry sack

Tarp or tent Flares Extra food Weather radio

VHF radio, PLB, or SPOT locator
